Jay Shelton and Puneet Dwivedi will discuss the science behind sustainable forest management and BMPs and explore the ways in which they are critical to good forestry management in Georgia.

Instructors

Dr. Puneet Dwivedi is an Associate Professor of Sustainability Sciences at the University of Georgia Warnell School of Forestry and Natural Resources. He specializes in the area of wood-based energy development, forest certification, land use change modeling, and family forest landowners.

Dr. Jay Shelton is an Associate Professor of Fisheries at the University of Georgia Warnell School of Forestry and Natural Resources. He specializes in water quality management. In 2018 Jay led a team of faculty, staff, and students from the University of Georgia in habitat restoration efforts on the Oconee River near Athens, Georgia. As a result of this project, the Warnell School was recognized as "Clean Water Heroes" by the Georgia Water Coalition, receiving their Clean 13 Award.
