Sustainable forest management and Best Management Practices (BMPs) are proven, common sense measures, methods and practices which enhance the economic, social and environmental values of forests, for the benefit of present and future generations. **Dr. Jay Shelton** is an Associate Professor of Fisheries at the University of Georgia Warnell School of Forestry and Natural Resources. He specializes in water quality management. In 2018 Jay led a team of faculty, staff, and students from the University of Georgia in habitat restoration efforts on the Oconee River near Athens, Georgia. As a result of this project, the Warnell School was recognized as "Clean Water Heroes" by the Georgia Water Coalition, receiving their Clean 13 Award.
